Many Americans are only now learning of this tragedy. There is no scientific basis for race; race and racism are social constructs. Balancing Cultures recalls a dark chapter in American history--censored in part by the Japanese precept of gaman (enduring the seemingly unbearable with patience and dignity) and the fear that if their voices were too loud, it might happen again. I raise my voice today because it is happening again.
